

Eugene Dunshee Rites Wednesday

Services will be held Wednesday at 2 p.m. at the Epsilon E.U.B. Church for Eugene W. Dunshee, 81 who died unexpectedly last night enroute to Lockwood General Hospital after suffering a heart attack at his home in Springvale township. The Rev. Jack Mulder will officiate and interment will be in the Curtiss cemetery.

He was born June 21, 1883 at Springvale, and with the exception of 10 years spent in Petoskey, was a lifelong resident of Springvale township. He was married to Miss Leola Hopper on December 6, 1916 and she preceded him in death in September 1945. He was a member of the Epsilon E.U.B. Church and a carpenter by trade.

He is survived by four sons, Arthur and Herschel of Springvale, Clyde of Plainville, Conn. and Richard of Vicksburg; two daughters, Mrs. J. V.
